The petitioner has placed on record the copy of one report which appears to have been obtained from the office of United Nations High Commission For Human Rights of preventable maternal mortality and morbidity and Human Rights wherein it has been mentioned that at least 80% of the Indian maternal deaths could be prevented if women simply had access to essential maternal and basic health care services and thereafter, it is mentioned that National Rural Health Mission in Jharkhand has utterly failed to provide facilities to the women and families of Sunderpahari and Poraiyahat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as per the petitioner's research work, the petitioner found that 24 ladies died during delivery in short period in the district of Godda.

Respondent nos.3,4 & 5 filed counter affidavit and took the matter seriously and it has been stated in Para 7 that committee consisting of Director Health, Health Services, State RCH officers, Health Services of the Government of Jharkhand, Regional Deputy Director, Health Services, Santhal Division, Administrative & Finance Officers and one doctor, Gunjam Taneja, State Representative, MCHIP has been constituted.

It is submitted that two months' time may be given to the committee who may submit the report.

In view of the above, time is granted.

Put up this case on 10th June, 2013 immediately after summer vacation.
